

# BONNY OAKS ASKS FOR SECOND POOL ~~TIME 5-7-25-56~~ Swimming Facility Sought for Colored Children

Appointment of a committee to obtain funds for construction of a swimming pool at Bonny Oaks School for colored children was endorsed by the institution's trustees yesterday.

A few hours later, County Judge Wilkes T. Thrasher reported that Harry Miller, retired businessman, had been named committee chairman. Adolph Shelby Ochs, secretary and treasurer of The Chattanooga Times, also has accepted a post on the committee.

The idea of constructing a pool for the colored children at Bonny Oaks was presented to the board by Malcolm Adamson, administrator.

White children of the school recently began swimming in a new pool donated by Attorney and Mrs. Charles B. Coleman.

The pool for colored children would be similar to the one contributed by the Colemans.
