

## A LITTLE GIRL'S WISH COMES TRUE: POOL IS DEDICATED AT BONNY OAKS



A beautiful 30x60-foot swimming pool, gift of Atty. and Mrs. Charles Coleman of Chattanooga to the boys and girls at Bonny Oaks School, yesterday was dedicated in memory of Lewis Minor Coleman Jr., brother of Atty. Coleman. Lewis Coleman drowned Aug. 28, 1914, at Hales Bar in the Tennessee River. The Rev. Robert Clapp, pastor of Tyner Baptist Church, gave the dedicatory prayer. Earlier Josephine Denson, a student, had wished for a bathing suit when Civitan Coleman was assigned her 10th birthday to "remember" in club custom for each of the members. Atty. and Mrs. Coleman then conceived the idea of the pool as a gift. In less than 20 days the pool was finished by Hyatt Construction Co.
