

BOOSTER WANTS NEW STRUCTURE AT BONNY OAKS

Now That Chapel Has Been Promised, Crosby Sug- gests Four-Story Brick.

Having witnessed the victory of the campaign for the erection of John W. Bachman chapel at Bonny Oaks School, William H. (Bing) Crosby, Bonny Oaks booster, now wants to launch a movement for a four-story brick building at the school.

The chapel was made a WPA project last week and will be built by the Government. Mr. Crosby yesterday offered the following suggestions:

"Why not build a modern four-story brick building at Bonny Oaks. This building would be worth thousands of dollars to this famous institution for generations to come. We will install a modern swimming pool, library, cannery, gymnasium, mechanical shop, sewing room, arts, and a modern electrical kitchen.

"This would give these unfortunate children a chance to prepare themselves for a bright future when they get ready to start out in life on their own. This institution deserves anything we can give it in honor of the dear and loved Christian pioneers that founded this sacred place.

"Dr. J. W. Bachman was one of the greatest Christians this country has ever known. We will also beautify the land east of Bonny Oaks with a lily pond, flower garden, shrubbery, evergreens, beautiful shade trees, a miniature home of Dr. J. W. Bachman that stood on McCallie Avenue for a number of years, baseball diamond, tennis court, and anything else which may help to make it more beautiful.

"We will ask the support and co-operation of all the citizens in all walks of life to get back of this great work.

"We should make these improvements now while we can get Federal Government aid in this great and valuable work. We will also erect monuments with bust statues for some of the pioneers that founded this great place.

"The entire history from the beginning of this work will be put in miniature raised letters on bronze tablets. This institution will be the greatest of its kind in the world. It will bring tourists from all parts of the globe to inspect and praise it, so that they can pattern after it for their unfortunate and homeless children."
